



Referee Code of Conduct and Expectations

Standards of Conduct:

All MYSC officials shall adhere to the following Standards of Conduct:

- Conduct themselves with dignity both on and off the field of play and shall, by example, endeavor to inspire the true principles of fair play and earn the respect of those whom they serve;
- Adhere to all standards and directives;
- Always be neat in appearance and maintain a high level of physical and mental fitness;
- Study the Laws of the Game and be aware of all changes, and shall enforce all said Laws and changes;
- Perform their designated responsibilities, including attending organized clinics and lectures, etc., and shall assist their colleagues in upgrading and improving their standards of officiating, instructing, and assessing;
- Honour any appointments made for and accepted by them unless unable to do so by virtue of illness or personal emergency;
- Be subject to disciplinary action for not complying with this Code of Conduct.

Expectations:

- All pay sheets will be submitted to the MYSC office by the 29th of each month
 - If late, may not be processed until the following month
- Each and every game acceptance will be deemed your responsibility to fulfill:
 - If you are not able to attend the game, the ensuing procedures are to be followed:
 - If game is more than 7 days away, you can let MYSC office know and they will find a replacement referee
 - If game is within 7 days, you need to find replacement referee yourself
 - No Shows and Sickness:
 - First time = warning
 - Second time = MYSC discretion and may be taken off the schedule for remainder of season
- All scores will be entered into Ref Savvy by 11:59pm of each accepted game day
- All disciplinary reports and game incidents must be submitted to the MYSC office within 24 hours after the game
