Required Training for Volunteer Coaches, Volunteer Trainers and Volunteer Team Managers

At Milton Magic FC we want to ensure that all bench staff:

- 1. Volunteer Team Managers are certified with current <u>Respect in Sports</u> and <u>Making Head Way in</u> <u>Soccer</u>. Along with a current <u>Vulnerable Sector Check</u> on file.
- 2. Volunteer Coaches are certified with current <u>Respect in Sports</u> and <u>Making Head Way in Soccer</u>. Along with a current <u>Vulnerable Sector Check</u> on file. As well with any various coaches' courses needed depending on the age group.
- 3. Volunteer Trainers with a current <u>Vulnerable Sector Check</u> on file and are certified with update <u>First Aid Training</u>.

Please note these are all personal expenses. Unless the team has made an agreement to cover these funds for the volunteer.

This code applies to all Volunteer Coaches, Volunteer Trainers, and Volunteer Team Managers. It is to ensure a safe a positive environment, by always making the club standard to coincide with Canada Soccer's core values.
