Hello Parents,

I understand there is a concern that a minimal number of parents have brought forth in the past few days regarding the ability to watch their children during the training sessions. The dome management company and the club in partnership are requesting parents not stay inside the dome during the training sessions and the reasons have been outlined below.

- 1. There is minimal space for parents to stand on the side of the field. With the goals, there is no space.
- 2. The ability to evacuate quickly from the dome in case of an emergency is difficult with the number of parents inside and on the sidelines.
- 3. We had tried to have parents stay on the sidelines of the field (entrance side) and we still have parents who have ignored the directions and stand in other parts of the dome.
- 4. We have parents who standing inside the field talking with one another and to be honest not watching the training session. Parents can socialize inside the fieldhouse
- 5. We have advised parents to no food or drinks inside the building other than water and parents ignore the directions of the management company and it is a brand-new turf field.
- 6. We have siblings who jump onto the field to kick the ball thinking they can because the area is free from the team not using the area and parents permit this even after reminders.
- 7. The coaches of the teams have also requested parents not come into the dome as the noise level is extremely high and their instructions can not be heard by the players
- 8. Parking is another issue with 8 teams being in the dome. On October 23, 2024, we had an issue with a player who was almost hit by a car not being aware.
- 9. Parents were advised in their parent meetings these past few weeks with the coaches.

Exceptions are:

- CK Dome where there is room for parents to sit and watch is permissible Tuesdays and Thursdays
- 2. U8s can come in until Nov 14, 2025, so the parents feel comfortable knowing their children are safe and in good hands
- 3. If there is an exhibition game, then parents are permitted to come into the dome to watch



The sport has changed and is similar to other sports where parents can drop off their children and attend to other things they might do. We would appreciate the support of the parents, so coaches and staff do not have to keep acting as security.
